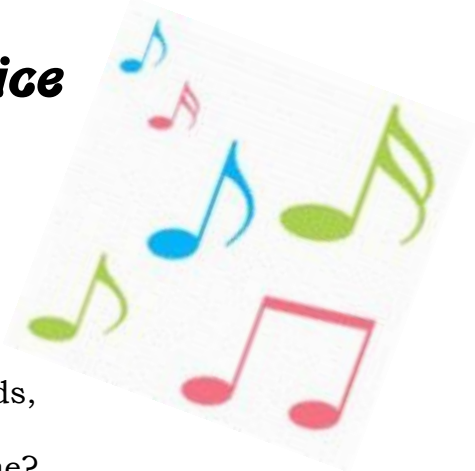
Shalom chaverim, shalom! (4x)
